**IMPORTANT NOTE**

- Read this prospectus carefully.
- Fill admission form very carefully. All the required information must be given correct. If it may false, the admission may be cancelled or the Principal may take action against it.
- Students, parents and guardian should pay special attention towards;
- 90% attendance at theory and practical classes.
- Rules regarding all concessions, freships, scholarship and other financial aids.
- Students must appear for unit test/terminal examination conducted by college and pass with 40% minimum marks

**PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION:**

Admission of students shall commence as soon as the results of Higher Secondary Examination are declared. Candidates should apply in the prescribed form.

Form along with a prospectus shall be available in the college office. Form can be submitted at the counter along with an admission fee at the time of submission.

Admission process is monitored by the Admission Committee. Admission is made strictly on the basis of merit. Government criteria in respect of reservation of seats for scheduled caste/scheduled tribes and physically handicapped students are strictly followed.

Following documents are necessary at the time of admission.

- Photocopies of Mark sheet of the Madhyamik board i.e. "X" (original to be produced for verification at the time of admission);
- Photocopies of higher secondary (+2) mark sheet and original copy of character certificate from the head of the institution studied last;
- Four recent revenue-size (2 cm. x 2.5 cm.) photographs duly signed by the candidate in the backside of the photograph;
- Monthly/annual Income Certificate of parent issued by competent authority (i.e. Gram Pradhan or B.D.O.);
- Photocopy of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes (Other backward Classes/Physically Handicapped Certificate (where applicable) issued by the competent authority;
- Migration Certificate in case of students coming from other University/Board; Adhar Card & Election Card.
- After the merit list is published the students should get themselves admitted within the stipulated date and time, failing which their candidatures admission are liable to be cancelled.

**ENROLLMENT**

All students who are new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the university. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time

**RAGGING**  
Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the noticed of the authority, strict action will be taken.

**PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP**  
All the backward class students and students under the lower income group should apply the govt. of India Post Matric Scholarship in the prescribed form to the college office after admission is confirmed. The application form is made available to them in the scholarship section or scholarship website.

- Minority scholarship available for minority students
- The students having a gap in education should variably file a court affidavit declaring as to what he/she was doing the intereuring period.
- Rajesh Chitrapati Shahu Maharaaj Shishan Shulkh Shishayavrutti Scheme (RCSMSSSS) : Those having annual income less than Rs.8,00,000/- are declared as economically backward. Their fees are reimbursed by the state government.
- Hindustan petroleum corporation limited (HPCL) : OBC, SC, ST, handicap (PWOT) Students those having annual income less than Rs.2 Lakh (2,00,000/-). Noncreamy layer Certificate compulsory for OBC. Students and 40% Marks in lower stage education is compulsory for all the backward class students.

**General Instructions to Students Regarding Conduct and Discipline**

- Students must not enter or leave the class without the permission of the lecturer when the class commences and continues;
