**POLICY DOCUMENT FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY GENERATION,
WASTE MANAGEMENT, WATER CONSERVATION AND GREEN
CAMPUS**

Policy for Renewable Energy Generation:

- ❖ Currently, the country is witnessing a power crisis. On one hand, power plants are experiencing shortage of coal, on the other hand, people are suffering due to power outages during hot summers. Green energy can be very helpful in overcoming power crises in such difficult times. As people are often worried about the monthly electricity bills, the owner of the college building has installed solar panels in the college. The electricity we generate is given to the Maharashtra Electricity Board and the electricity we use is deducted from our consumption and remains billed to us and we save electricity and our electric bill by generating it. College is focusing on renewable energy generation.

Energy Saving Policy:

- ✓ LED lights have been installed in the entire college and classrooms LED light helps to save electricity. College decides to accept advanced technology to save energy presently like LED lighting, low electricity consumption equipment (Fan, AC, Monitors, TV, CPU, etc.)
- ✓ College should promote the use of bicycles and inspire students to use pedestrian roads, public transport and vehicle sharing systems for petrol saving.

Policy for waste Management

Water Waste:

- All the waste water in the college is collected through pipes and stored in the water safety tank. After collection, the water sent to Soak pit. Pieces of stone, soil, sand, and bricks are laid in the Soak pit. The main purpose is to conserve the water and save the earth from soil pollution.

Degradable Waste:

- After collecting the entire waste papers, waste files and packaging boxes, dust, waste food, grass, etc. have been collected and dumped in the D Compost Unit set up in the college. Bacterial decomposition process takes place in D Compost tank for a year after which the manure is removed and fed to the plants in the college campus which helps in the growth of the plants.

Non-Degradable Waste:

- Plastics, wrappers, stationary waste, etc. the non-degradable waste have been collected in a bin, and the solid waste vehicle comes and the entire plastic is sent to the disposal

College will continue and maintain the water conservation activity and increase it as per need.

Policy for Green Campus:

- ❖ Plantation is done every year by the NSS unit in the college. Also, a garden has been created behind the college. Different types of trees have been planted in the campus area mostly near the compound wall. And for the protection of the entire tree, he was planted and nourished. College has decided to plant at least 30 trees every year in the campus and try to plant more plants in nearby areas with the help of students.

Policy for awareness:
